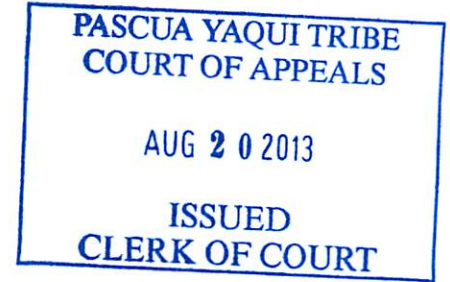

**ORDER**

Appeal based on TC case CV-12-067.

The jurisdiction of the Pascua Yaqui Court of Appeals extends to all appeals from final orders and judgments of the Tribal Court, in both civil and criminal matters. See Pascua Yaqui Const., art. VIII, §5 and the Pascua Yaqui Court of Appeals Procedures Act of 2000, §1.12.

On March 19, 2013 Appellant Rendon filed a notice of appeal based on a final judgment for Tribal Court case CV-12-067. Appellant filed a Notice of Arraignment of Transcription of Hearing for CV 12-067 on March 27, 2013 but never filed an actual transcript. Since then, Appellant has not filed a transcript or an opening brief. On April 17, 2013 Mr. Brahms, counselor for Appellant, withdrew representation.

Pursuant 3 PYTC § 2-3-120(B), the chief justice may summarily dismiss the appeal if the appellant fails to timely file the record. This appeal is summarily dismissed for failure to timely file the record.
