RELEASE OF CASH BOND
PRE-TRIAL ORDER AND
ORDER FOR TRIAL SETTING

The defendant, Jesus Gabriel Alvarez, appeared without legal counsel, in custody, for a pre-trial conference on July 20, 2009. G. Allen Osburn appeared for the Tribe.


The court asked the defendant if he understood he had a right to make pre-trial motions, including the right to suppress evidence and to exclude evidence and witnesses, and he had no such motions. The Court finds that the Tribe does not have any pending pre-trial motions for the court's review and consideration. The court should adopt the previous conditions and release the defendant on a suspended bond, and the court should set this matter for a trial. The Court should grant the surety's unopposed motion for return of the cash bond.

IT IS ORDERED that the case is set for a bench trial on August 19, 2009 at 10:00 a.m.. The Defendant, Jesus Gabriel Alvarez, shall be released on a \$75.00 bond, to be posted, he must appear at all future scheduled hearings, and obey all laws, pending the trial. He shall not consume nor possess any alcoholic beverages and he shall be subject to random breath alcohol testing by law enforcement. In the event he does not post his cash bond, then the Court shall issue a transport order.

THIS IS THE ONLY NOTICE OF HEARING YOU WILL RECEIVE.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the \$75.00 cash bond shall be exonerated and returned to the surety, Andrea Matus. The defendant must post another \$75.00 cash bond.
