The PASCUA YAQUI TRIBE, hereby complains and alleges, upon information and belief, that the above named defendant, an Indian, did commit the following offense(s):

**COUNT 1: DISORDERLY CONDUCT, 4 PYTC SEC. 1-170(A)**

On or about June 4, 2009 at approximately 2:40 p.m., in the street at or near 7552 Parros Voo'o, with the intent to disturb the peace or quiet of a neighborhood, family or person or with knowledge of doing so by engaging in fighting, violent or seriously disruptive behavior to wit: **Mr. Cordova fought with Amy Garcia in her front yard.**

**COUNT 2: BATTERY: 4 PYTC SEC. 1-170 (A)**

On or about June 4, 2009 at approximately 2:40 p.m., in the street at or near 7552 Parros Voo'o, willfully strike another person or otherwise inflict bodily injury, or who shall by offering violence cause another to harm shall deemed guilty of an offense to wit: **Mr. Cordova willfully struck Amy Garcia on the forehead, Officers observed scratches and redness on Ms. Garcia.**

And such violations, upon conviction, are punishable under the Pascua Yaqui Tribal Codes.
