The PASCUA YAQUI TRIBE, hereby complains and alleges, upon information and belief, that the above named defendant, an Indian, while on the Pascua Yaqui Reservation, did commit the following offense(s):

COUNT 1: LIQUOR VIOLATION: 4, PYTC 1-640

On or about JUNE 9, 2009 at approximately 5:31 A.M., at or near BENEM AND WICHALAKAS, it is unlawfully for any person under the age of 21 years of age to buy, sell, or otherwise distribute, consume or possess any alcoholic beverage within the exterior boundaries of the Pascua Yaqui Indian Reservation

And such violations, upon conviction, are punishable under the Pascua Yaqui Tribal Codes.
