
ORDER SETTING BENCH TRIAL

The defendant, Antonio Monreal, in custody, appeared without legal counsel, for an arraignment, on August 26, 2009. Patricia Castro appeared for the Tribe. The defendant was read his rights, he waived reading of the criminal complaint and he entered a plea of not guilty to Count One, Domestic Violence Disorderly Conduct, Count Two, Domestic Violence, Threatening or Intimidating, Count Three, Domestic Violence, Tampering with Communications, Count Four, Injury to Public Property, Count Five, Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs, and Count Six, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, that the Tribe recommends defendant be released on a \$500.00 cash bond, based on prior contempt of court orders. The defendant should be ordered to not contact the alleged victims, Andrea Ranny and Vicente Camacho, and the residence of 5517 Maaso Voo'o, he should obey all laws, appear at all future hearings, and not consume narcotics and dangerous drugs or possess drug paraphernalia. The defendant objected, requested a suspended bond because he attends school has two employment opportunity, helps assist in the care of a minor child and has connections in the community. Based on hew facts not considered in the earlier hearing, the Court should grant a lowered bond of \$300.00. The Court should deny the request for a pre-trial for lack of good cause shown.

IT IS ORDERED that the defendant, Antonio Monreal, shall be released on a \$300.00 cash bond, to be posted, he shall appear at all future hearings, obey all laws, and the defendant shall not contact the alleged victims, Andrea Ranny and Vicente Camacho, and the address of 5517 Maaso Voo'o. He shall not consume nor possess any Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs, not possess drug paraphernalia, and he shall be subject to random urinalysis testing by law enforcement. The Court denies the request for a pre-trial conference for lack of good cause shown.

A BENCH TRIAL shall be scheduled for October 7, 2009 at 10:00 p.m.. In the event he cannot post his cash bond, the court shall issue a transport order. He shall provide the Court with a new address within 24 hours of his release from custody. **THIS IS THE ONLY NOTICE OF HEARING YOU WILL RECEIVE.**
