The defendant, Belinda Baltazar, appeared with her legal counsel, Lourdes Lopez, for a change of plea hearing on June 23, 2008. Appearing for the Tribe was Yancy Jencsok.

The defendant entered a plea of guilty to CR-08-083, Count Two, Assault, CR-08-163, Count One, Disorderly Conduct Domestic Violence, Count Two, Disorderly Conduct Domestic Violence and Count Four, Battery Domestic Violence, and by stipulating to the facts alleged, she stipulated to the facts as alleged in the Counts above, and there is a factual basis for acceptance of the plea. The Court is satisfied that the defendant fully understands the nature of the charges and the terms and conditions and consequences of her admitting she committed the offense as alleged in CR-08-083, Count Two, Assault, CR-08-163, Count One, Disorderly Conduct Domestic Violence, Count Two, Disorderly Conduct Domestic Violence and Count Four, Battery Domestic Violence, of the respective complaints. She entered the guilty plea without force, threat, or special promises made to her to do so. The Court should accept the defendant's plea, and it should issue an order sentencing the defendant as recommended by the Tribe in the plea agreement. The defendant should be ordered to pay a \$247.80 court costs 60 days after her release from detention.

Because there is no further necessity to maintain her cash bond in CR-08-083, the bond shall be exonerated and returned to the surety.

IT IS ORDERED that the defendant's plea of guilty is accepted as to CR-08-083, Count Two, Assault, CR-08-163, Count One, Disorderly Conduct Domestic Violence, Count Two, Disorderly Conduct Domestic Violence and Count Four, Battery Domestic Violence, and Belinda Baltazar shall be sentenced as follows:

CR-08-083, Count Two, Assault, 30 days detention, she shall not contact Guadalupe Salvador and Xavier Salvador for a period of one year and she shall not contact the address of 7540 S. Camino Huivisim for a period of one year, she shall pay \$247.80 court costs, by money order, no later than 60 days after her release from custody;

CR-08-163, Count One, Disorderly Conduct, Domestic Violence, 30 days detention, she shall not contact Bonita Baltazar for a period of one year;

Count Two, Disorderly Conduct, Domestic Violence. 30 days detention, not harm nor harass Randy Baltazar for a period of one year; and,

Count Four, Battery Domestic Violence, 10 days detention, and not contact Bonita Baltazar for a period of one year.


The detention days shall be served consecutively, beginning immediately.

The Court shall grant the tribe's motion to dismiss with prejudice TR-08-007, Count A, CR-08-083, Counts One and Three, and CR-08-163, Counts Three and Five.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the \$100.00 cash bond posted by the surety, Danielle Baltazar on December 26, 2007 shall be exonerated and returned to the surety.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the pre-trial hearing set in case no. CR-08-163, for July 21, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. and the jury trial set for July 29, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. shall be vacated.
